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| How to install SecureDoc Standalone

PREP: Check that your server(s) meet the product requirements for this version. Click [here](#) to review.

1. Download and save the SecureDoc to your device.
2. If you have previously installed a SecureDoc Trial version on your machine, uninstall it now.
 - a. Decrypt all encrypted drives
 - b. Uninstall Boot Logon (in the Control Center, click Boot Control, then install/uninstall Boot Logon, then the Uninstall tab)
 - c. Uninstall SecureDoc using the Windows Control Panel.
 - d. Delete the default folder for SecureDoc Disk Encryption, e.g. C:\Program Files\WinMagic\SecureDoc-NT
3. Download and review release notes and product documentation. PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOUR SERVER(S) MEET THE PRODUCT REQUIREMENTS
4. Install SecureDoc using the Installation Wizard. SecureDoc will guide you through the process of converting the entire disk to a securely encrypted disk.
